NOTICE OF HEARING

Pursuant to the provisions of the Rhode Island General Laws §§39-1, 39-26-6 et seq. and 39-1-27.8, as amended, the Public Utilities Commission (the "Commission") will conduct a hearing on **Thursday, August 27, 2009 @ 9:30 A.M.** in Hearing Room A of the Public Utilities Commission, located at 89 Jefferson Boulevard, Warwick, Rhode Island. The hearing may continue thereafter from day to day and time to time as required.

In this docket, the Commission will examine the propriety of Narragansett Electric Company d/b/a National Grid's proposed Procurement Plans to meet its Standard Offer and Renewable Energy supply requirements beginning January 1, 2010. The plans includes procurement procedures, pricing options being sought by the Company and proposed term of service for which Standard Offer and Renewable Energy supply will be acquired. Although this proceeding will not set retail rates for the existing customers, approval of National Grid's proposed procurement plans will impact the retail rates which will ultimately be set as a result of National Grid's procurement of power supply for the period commencing January 1, 2010.

The filing may be examined at the Commission's office and at the office of National Grid, 280 Melrose Street, Providence, Rhode Island. The filing can be accessed at www.ripuc.org, under the Commission Docket Menu, Docket No. 4041.

Reference is also made to Chapters 42-35 and 39-1 of the Rhode Island General Laws. Specifically Sections, 42-35-1, 42-35-2, 43-35-3, 42-35-4, 42-35-5, 39-1-1, 39-1-3, 39-1-11, 39-1-18 and 39-1-38.
